CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

ENTRY: Entry will be limited to 66 players. All entrants must conform to the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by R&A Rules Limited.

ENTRANCE FEE: The entrance fee is £25.00 per player, which will include a snack lunch and afternoon tea.

PARENTAL CONSENT: Applications will not be accepted unless accompanied by a completed parental consent form.

HANDICAP LIMIT: The handicap limit for entries is a Playing Handicap of **20 for boys** and **30 for girls**. In the event of a competition being over subscribed then those players with the higher handicaps will be balloted out of the draw and placed in Exact Handicap order on the reserve list. Handicap certificates must be produced on the day of the competition.

TEES: Tees in use will be the **WHITE** markers for boys and **RED** markers for girls.

LOCAL RULES: The Local Rules applicable are as printed on the score card. Any changes from and additions to these Local Rules will be notified on the day.

DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES: For all play at this course a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is actually used.

PACE OF PLAY: Each player is responsible for playing without undue delay. A strict pace of play policy will be operated.

CADDIES: Neither caddies nor trolley pullers will be permitted.

DRESS CODE: Boys will be required to wear a jacket and tie for prize giving. Girls should dress in an appropriate smart manner for prize giving. Appropriate smart casual golf attire is required on the golf course and in the Clubhouse at all other times. Denim and trainers are not appropriate.

MOBILE PHONES: May only be used in an emergency from the course or in the Clubhouse, otherwise their use is restricted to the car park area

MORNING COMPETITION

FORMAT: 18 holes stroke play competition (medal) in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and the Local Rules of North Hants Golf Club.

PRIZES:

Scratch: Winner (Daily Telegraph Trophy), runner-up, best North Hants G.C. player (The Armstrong Cup)

Handicap: Division 1 (to 9): Winner and runner-up; Division 2 (10 and over): Winner and runner-up

AFTERNOON COMPETITION

FORMAT: 18 holes stableford competition in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited and the Local Rules of North Hants Golf Club.

PRIZES:

Scratch: Winner and runner-up

Handicap: Division 1 (to 9): Winner and runner-up; Division 2 (10 and over): Winner and runner-up

PRIZE WINNERS: No competitor may win more than one prize.

TIES: All ties will be decided on the last 9,6,3 or final hole as may be necessary.

COMMITTEE: The Junior Open is organised by the Junior Committee of North Hants Golf Club, which will rule on any dispute which may arise and its decision shall be final.
